2. Class Counsel is hereby awarded attorneys' fees of \$_____. The Court finds that the amount of fees awarded is fair and reasonable given the substantial risks of non-recovery, the time and effort involved, and the results obtained for the Settlement Class.

3. Class Counsel is hereby awarded reimbursement of expenses in the sum of \$_____. The Court finds that the expenses were incurred in the litigation of this action and should be reimbursed.

4. Named Plaintiff Jeffrey Tucker is awarded \$_____ as an Incentive Fee, as defined in the Settlement Agreement, in recognition of his contribution to this Action.
